We look forward to seeing you all after the half term. Have a lovely break and lets hope the sun shines.

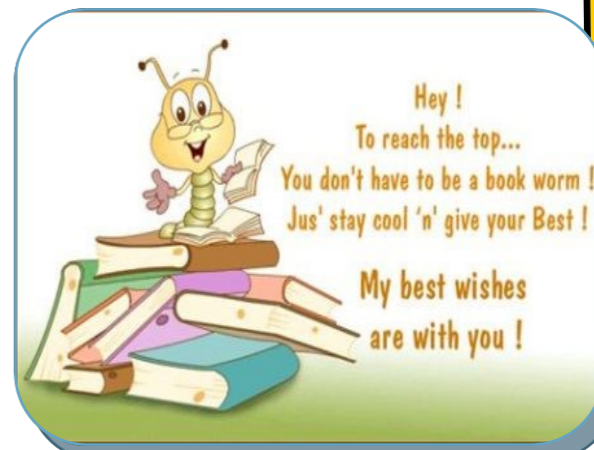
### SATS
